

#### RANDOLPH STREET BAPTIST CHURCH 99TH ANNIVERSARY

This year we celebrate 99 years of God's faithfulness to our local church! Randolph Street Baptist Church was born out of the fundamentalist-modernist controversy of the 1920s. The church began with a meeting of ninety-two believers on October 26, 1923, in the home of Mr. & Mrs. John W. Cooke at 609 Ohio Avenue. The first church service of the soon to be named, Fundamentals Baptist Church, met two days later at a vacant store room at 743 Virginia Street. This group of faithful men and women would move forward in seeking God's face by forming a new local church that would remain committed to the truths of Scripture for the glory of God.

On November 21, 1923, ninety-nine believers officially organized and chartered themselves as Fundamentals Baptist Church. In the following year, this group changed their name to match the location of the lot purchased on Randolph Street. Randolph Street Baptist Church's foundation stone was laid in 1926 and the building was dedicated on February 18, 1927.

Now, 99 years later, the purpose of our local church remains the same. Standing on the shoulders of these faithful men and women who loved their Savior and His church, our aim is to continue this commitment to truth and being a church that brings glory to our great God!
