

THE BAPTIST CATECHISM

Q16. What special act of providence did God exercise towards man when he was first created?

A16. When God had created man, he made a covenant with him that he should live and enjoy all the benefits of creation, but that he would die if he forsook the obedience that comes from faith. God commanded him not to eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, and thus forsake his child-like dependence upon God for all things.

Q17. Did our first parents continue in the glad obedience for which they were created?

A17. No, but desiring to be like God, our first parents forsook the obedience of faith, ate of the forbidden tree, sinned against God, and fell from the innocence in which they were created.

Walk for Life

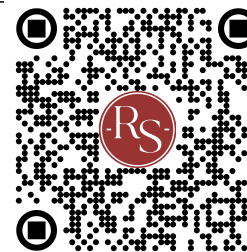
