


RANDOLPH STREET PROJECT

The Randolph Street Project is designed to prepare our local church for our next chapter of gospel ministry together on the West Side of Charleston. This campaign will fund the purchase of 210 Virginia Street and allow us to pursue the following ministry objectives.

- Add a 4,700 sq/ft fellowship hall that can seat our entire church family for dinners and events.
- Grow opportunities for gospel outreach to our direct community by hosting efforts to demonstrate the love of Christ and to declare the gospel of Christ to our neighbors.
- Expand space for discipleship classes for our adults (Sunday mornings) and our students (Sunday evenings).
- Create over 3,000 sq/ft of outdoor recreation space for families and children to spend time together.
- Add additional space for receptions, parties, and various events hosted by our church family.
- Extend our parking by adding 20 additional spaces for our Sunday gatherings.
- Develop another layer of security by allowing us to fence off all areas behind our current church property.

Our goal is to raise 450k by June 2027 to fund this initiative. Information regarding the Randolph Street project and campaign commitment forms can be found on the back table. If you have questions, you can contact any of our elders serving on the Project Team.
