**THE HEIDELBERG CATECHISM**

**Q15.** What kind of mediator and deliverer should we look for then?

**A15.** One who is a true<sup>1</sup> and righteous<sup>2</sup> human, yet more powerful than all creatures, that is, one who is also true God.<sup>3</sup>

**Q16.** Why must the mediator be a true and righteous human?

**A16.** God's justice demands that human nature, which has sinned, must pay for sin;<sup>1</sup> but a sinful human could never pay for others.<sup>2</sup>

**Q17.** Why must the mediator also be true God?

**A17.** So that the mediator, by the power of his divinity, might bear the weight of God's wrath in his humanity and earn for us and restore to us righteousness and life.<sup>1</sup>
