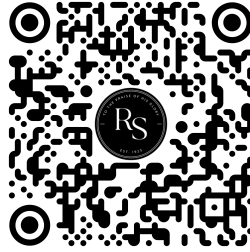

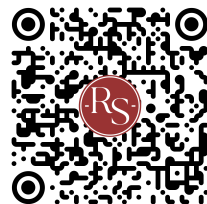
RANDOLPH STREET PROJECT

The Randolph Street Project is designed to prepare our local church for our next chapter of gospel ministry together on the West Side of Charleston. Initially this will fund the purchase of 210 Virginia Street and allow us to pursue the following ministry objectives.

- Add a 4,700 sq/ft fellowship hall that can seat our entire church family for dinners and events.
- Grow opportunities for gospel outreach to our direct community by hosting efforts to demonstrate the love of Christ and to declare the gospel of Christ to our neighbors.
- Expand space for discipleship classes for our adults (Sunday mornings) and our students (Sunday evenings).
- Create over 4,000 sq/ft of outdoor recreation space for families and children to spend time together.
- Add additional space for receptions, parties, and various events hosted by our church family.
- Extend our parking by adding 20 additional spaces for our Sunday gatherings.
- Develop another layer of security by allowing us to fence off all areas behind our current church property.
