SOLA GRATIA

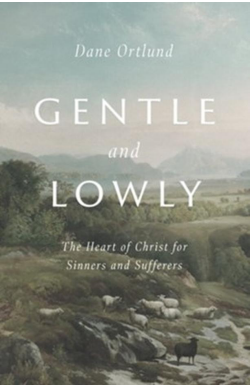
Our salvation rests solely on the work of God’s grace for us.
