SOLA GRATIA

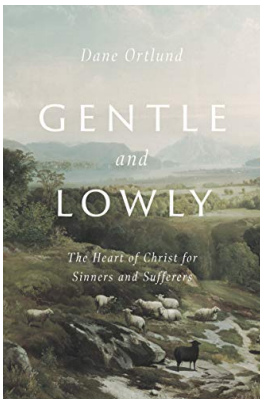
Our salvation rests solely on the work of God’s grace for us.

RANDOLPH STREET CATECHISM

*Taken from the Baptist Catechism as edited by John Piper.

Question 45: What is the duty which God requires of man?

Answer 45: The duty which God requires of man is the obedience that comes from faith.

Scripture: Galatians 5:6; 1 Thessalonians 1:3; 2 Thessalonians 2:11; Romans 1:5; 16:26; 15:18

Q&A 42: What benefits do believers receive from Christ at the Resurrection? At the resurrection, believers are raised up in glory; they shall be openly acknowledged and acquitted in the Day of Judgment, and made perfectly blessed in the full enjoyment of God to all eternity.

Q&A 43: What shall be done to the wicked at death? The souls of the wicked shall at death, be cast into the torments of hell, and their bodies lie in their graves till the resurrection and judgment of the great day.

Q&A 44: What shall be done to the wicked at the Day of Judgment? At the Day of Judgment, the bodies of the wicked, being raised out of their graves shall be sentenced, together with their souls, to unspeakable torments with the devil and his angels forever.
