**THE HEIDELBERG CATECHISM**

**Q39. Is it significant that he was "crucified" instead of dying some other way?**

**A39.** Yes. By this I am convinced that he shouldered the curse which lay on me, since death by crucifixion was cursed by God.<sup>1</sup>
