Our June song of the month is a hymn written by Charles Haddon Spurgeon in 1866. Spurgeon pastored the Metropolitan Tabernacle from 1854-1892 and left a legacy of rich, doctrinal preaching. In addition to his preaching, lectures, and books, Spurgeon wrote several hymns. This hymn was originally entitled "Amidst Us Our Beloved Stands" and has been updated by Trudy Poirier.
