### GOSPEL PARTNER HIGHLIGHT

#### TO THE END OF THE EARTH PROJECT — TEAM #1

The team has a long-term vision to plant healthy churches among a people group who has no access to the gospel in their language and no known believers. In order to accomplish this, the team will need to learn multiple languages and cultures, and start and maintain a business in order to gain access to the country and the people group. They have chosen a country in SE Asia due to the number of unreached language groups and the opportunities for access through business.

Please pray for this team as they acclimate to the country, learn languages, decide on a target group, and develop a plan for long term residency and gospel outreach. Ultimately pray that Christ will use this team to build His church!

In 2021, together we raised funds through our "To the End of the Earth" campaign that allows us to support this team for a minimum of two years.
