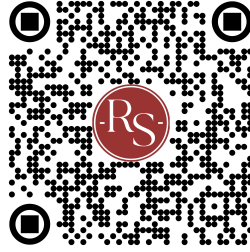

### GOSPEL PARTNER HIGHLIGHT

RISEN KING IN HURRICANE, WV

Risen King holds a very special place in the hearts of our Randolph Street family. In the spring of 2014, Randolph Street launched the Valley campus at the West Teays Elementary School in Hurricane. In November of that year, the campus moved to the Commons at Valley Park. Tim and Jason shared the preaching responsibilities for the campus ministry. Peter Ambler began to assume some of the preaching opportunities along with Jason and Tim until taking over the primary pulpit ministry in 2019. Randolph Street officially set Risen King apart in July of 2019 as an autonomous local church, meeting at their present facility in Hurricane. Peter continues to serve as the lead pastor with several godly men as elders and deacons. Peter asks us to pray for unity among their body and wisdom in pursuing faithful ministry inside and outside their congregation.
