GOSPEL PARTNER HIGHLIGHT

TO THE END OF THE EARTH PROJECT — TEAM #2

In 2021, together, we raised funds through our “To the End of the Earth” campaign that allows us to support two teams for a minimum of two years who are focused on unreached people groups. A few weeks ago, we highlighted Team 1 (SE Asia), and today we focus on Team 2.

Team 2 is in a different SE Asian country that is closed to evangelism and missions. This teams consists of two families who have a long term vision for a healthy, local church planted among a particular, unreached people group. They are currently in country and seeking wisdom in how to move forward. They write, “The goal of our team is to expend our lives living fully for God’s glory by His grace and in His strength. The way that we have decided to take up this task is to give ourselves in labor to see a healthy, biblical, indigenous church established among a language group in *** that does not have one.”
