May Congregational Hymns

If you are interested in a copy of every hymn we will sing in May, it is located on the back table. Most hymns have the music, some just the lyrics. The page number for each hymn is located beside the song in the liturgy. Below are a few hymns we will sing a couple of times in May.

See the Destined Day Arise

Originally penned as a poem in the 6th century, this hymn has been rewritten a couple of times. The most recent, and the version we sing, is by Matt Merker. This song is full of gospel truth, focusing on the sacrificial death of Jesus. "Who but Christ had dared to drain, Steeped in gall, the cup of pain — And with tender body bear — Thorns and nails and piercing spear? — Slain for us, the water flowed, — Mingled from Your side with blood; — Sign to all attesting eyes — Of the finished sacrifice."

From Everlasting (Psalm 90)

Psalm 90 is a unique Psalm as it is attributed to Moses. It is a prayer to the faithful God, the One who is "from everlasting to everlasting." The hymn is written to capture the truth of Psalm 90 as the chorus reminds us, "And all our days are held within Your hands — Your perfect love and favor have no end — We rest within the wisdom of Your plan — Everlasting God." Music and words by Lisa Clow and Lacy Hudson.

Christ Is Mine Forevermore

This is another recent Christ-centered song from City Alight. The lyrics remind us that we were made for God, to walk with and worship Him, and that through sorrow, darkness, and valleys, we know our pain will not be wasted as Christ completes his work in us. Throughout this song, our lips and hearts will rehearse, "Christ is mine forevermore." The words and music are written by Jonny Robinson & Rich Thompson.

I Woke Up this Morning

This African American hymn (author unknown) was written for the congregation to exhort one another to stay focused on Jesus. The lyrics are pointed, "Can't hate your neighbor in your mind, stayed on Jesus," and they are comforting, "No condemnation with my mind, stayed on Jesus."
