2024 Theology Seminars

Throughout the year, we are offering intensives focused on various doctrines, books of the Bible, and church history. These sessions will include two hours of intense study that will help the student understand the “big picture” of each subject and grow us in our understanding of God’s Word. Several of the subjects to be covered in 2024 are Old Testament Survey, New Testament Survey, Eschatology, Gospel of John (two sessions), Reformation History & Theology, and Christology.

The first intensive is Old Testament Survey. This class will give you help you understand the overall storyline/structure of the OT and how it all fits together in Christ. This seminar will be offered on Wednesday, February 7th, at 7pm-9pm. We are not providing childcare so there will be an option to join us via the live feed with a provided password. In order to prepare handouts, we need everyone to sign up (in person and online) on the back table. We need a minimum of ten students to offer the class.

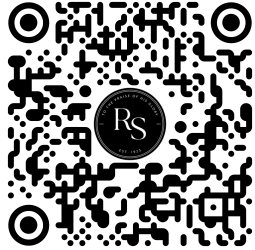
