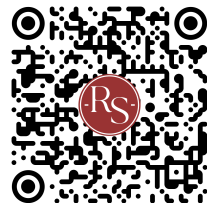

### THE LORD'S TABLE & OUR LORD'S DAY GATHERING

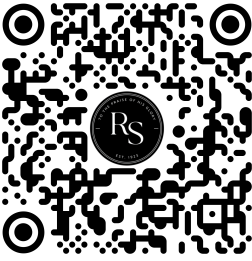
